EBOOKS

Access full text online books via the **SPC Library Online** at <http://www.spcollege.edu/central/libonline/>. Under **Top Links**, click on **netLibrary**. You may search by Keyword, Title, Author or Full-Text.

FULL TEXT ELECTRONIC DATABASES

Students and faculty may access these via the **SPC Library Online** at <http://www.spcollege.edu/central/libonline/>. These provide access to full text articles in scholarly journals, business periodicals, magazines and newspapers.

- Business Source Elite** (Ebsco)

Full text coverage of more than 1,100 scholarly business and economics journals.

- Regional Business News** (Ebsco)

Full text database covers 75 business journals, newspapers and newswires from all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States.

- Communication And Mass Media Complete** (Ebsco)

Full text database indexes over 40,000 titles, including publications in the fields of advertising and public relations.

- Computer Database** (Gale)

Full text database includes publications on business technologies and e-commerce.

- Custom Newspapers** (Gale)

Database of 175 national and international newspapers. Divides results by sections: Arts and Entertainment, Business News, Lifestyle, News, Opinion and Editorial, Regional News, and Sports.

- General Business File Asap** (Gale)

Indexes research reports, trade publications, newspapers, journals, and company directory listings.

Reference USA lists basic information about 10.5 million businesses and allows creation of customized lists by type of business, geography, business size and more.
