### E-BOOKS

Access full text online books via the **SPC Library Online** at <http://www.spcollege.edu/central/libonline/>. Under **Top Links**, click on **E-Books**. You may search netLibrary by Keyword, Title, Author or Full-Text. Gale Virtual Reference Collections offer access to [Business Plans Handbook](#).

### FULL TEXT ELECTRONIC DATABASES

Students and faculty may access these via the **SPC Library Online** at <http://www.spcollege.edu/central/libonline/>. Click on **Articles & Databases** (password available from Librarian). These provide access to full text articles in scholarly journals, business periodicals, magazines and newspapers.

- Business Source Premier and Business Source Premier – Enhanced Business Search** (Ebsco)

Full text coverage of more than 1,400 business journals, magazines and trade publications.

- Regional Business News** (Ebsco)

Full text database covers 75 business journals, newspapers and newswires from all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States. Updated on a daily basis.

- Communication And Mass Media Complete** (via CMMC)

Full text database indexes over 400 titles, including publications in the fields of advertising and public relations.

- Computer Database** (Gale)

Full text database on ISO key technology periodicals which include publications on business technologies and e-commerce.

- Custom Newspapers** (via Infotrac/Gale)

Database of 150 national newspapers including the New York Times, the Atlanta Journal-Constitution, and 9 major Florida papers.

- General Business File ASAP** (Gale)

Analyzes company performance and activity, industry events and trends and the latest in management, economics, and politics. This international database provides access to 200,000 company profiles, more than 50,000 Investext reports, late-breaking news and event coverage on companies, industry products and executives.

- Computer Database** (via Infotrac)

An internet-accessible, reference solution, this database accesses the most influential periodicals on the computer, telecommunications and electronics industries.

•**Gale Virtual Ref-Business Plans** (via Galenet)

Gale Virtual Reference Library takes eBooks and delivers reference content in a database format.

•**IEEE-Computer**

The IEEE Computer Society Digital Library provides online access to 22 society magazines and transactions and over 1200 selected conference proceedings.

•**WilsonWeb Business**

Wilson Web Business provides full text for over 400 business publications, including newspapers, magazines, and journals.
